The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD) and the United Nations in Viet Nam (UN) would like to invite you to the 'debriefing of the joint rapid need assessments' in the most affected communities due to drought and saltwater intrusion in Central Highland, South Central and Mekong Delta regions.

Following the recent briefing of the Partners by MARD on 15th March regarding the emergency situation due to drought, saltwater intrusion and El-Nino impacts in Viet Nam, six inter-agency rapid need assessment missions, comprised of UN Agencies, MARD, and INGO experts, were deployed to the most affected communities of Ninh Thuan, Binh Thuan, Gia Lai, Kontum, Ben Tre and Kien Giang from the 21st to 24th March to conduct rapid assessment of humanitarian and most immediate needs of the households. On 30th March, the joint teams will present their findings and recommendations for an urgent response plan.
