### BACKGROUND

FHI 360 is a non-profit human development organization dedicated to improving lives in lasting ways by advancing integrated, locally driven solutions. Our staff includes experts in health, education, nutrition, environment, economic development, civil society, gender, youth, research and technology; creating a unique mix of capabilities to address today's interrelated development challenges. FHI 360 serves more than 60 countries, all 50 U.S. states and all U.S. territories.

The **Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC)** is a five-year, global project funded by the U.S. President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). EpiC Vietnam's goal is to deliver efficient, affordable, results-based technical assistance and direct services while closing remaining gaps in Vietnam's efforts to meet HIV epidemic control targets and address the global COVID-19 pandemic.

**We are seeking a qualified individual to develop and facilitate approval of the COVID-19 Aid Acceptance Plan and help facilitate EpiC's tax exemption/refund process.**

### SCOPE OF WORK

The qualified individual will collaborate with EpiC to work with the Finance and Planning Department of the Ministry of Health to develop an Aid Acceptance Plan for equipment and supplies supported by EpiC to targeted central and provincial hospitals majoring in provinces Ho Chi Minh City, Binh Duong, Dong Nai, Long An, Tay Ninh and flexible to other additional provinces and extended for upcoming fund. Once the plan is approved by the MOH, the consultant will coordinate with focal provinces on appropriate procedures for handing over

equipment and supplies. The consultant will then complete the tax exemption paperwork process. This plan will aim to facilitate a robust working mechanism with central/provincial recipients and enable the tax exemption/refund following regulations of Decree 80/2020/NĐ-CP dated 8 July 2020 and any additional regulations applicable.
