Terms of Reference for advanced Microsoft office training service

Oxfam is a global movement of people who are fighting inequality to end poverty and injustice. There are currently 21 member organizations working in 87 countries. 1. Background and rationale

Social organizations, non-state and nonprofit actors respond to the needs of vulnerable groups, towards a more equal society and narrowing the gap between divergent groups in society. NPOs' financial sustainability based on financial compliance and autonomy is important for them to play the above role.

Oxfam operates in a dynamic environment that is characterized by partnership building with many international donors, as well as other local organizations. This is coupled with the continued expectation that Oxfam upholds its integral values of accountability and transparency.
