

# TERMS OF REFERENCE TECHNICAL CONSULTANCY ON ENVIROMENT AND SOCIAL SUSTAINABILITY OF EXTRACTIVE ACTIVITIES

## 1. Background

- Organizing consultations with the participation of relevant stakeholders
- Conducting follow-up activities to promote environmental and social sustainablity of extractive activities

- Two review reports on environmental and social sustainablity of extractive activities, to be done before Feb 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Consultations with the participation of relevant stakeholders, to be done before May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Conducting follow-up activities to promote environmental and social sustainablity of extractive activities, to be done by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
