Job Purpose	VietHarvest is seeking an enthusiastic individual to support our food rescue operations in Hanoi, Vietnam. We are a new social enterprise, so a positive, proactive attitude is essential. The successful candidate will assist in the day-to-day management food rescue in Hanoi. The Project Officer will be responsible for coordinating food rescue with our food donors, charity partners, driver and Country Manager with an emphasis on timely service with an attention to detail and food safety and hygiene.
	The Project Officer will also support the Country Manager with administration of project documents, data collection and management and support with scaling up operations in Hanoi.
	The successful candidate may also contribute to special projects, fundraising activities, corporate engagement, events, community engagement and marketing and communications as and where required.

Background

VietHarvest is a social enterprise that aims to tackle food waste and hunger. We do this by collecting quality surplus food which we then redistribute to underserved communities in Vietnam.

- Support the Country Manager in scaling up food rescue
- As required, be available for special projects and marketing and comms

Key Duties and Responsibilities

Key Responsibility Area 1 - General Operations (70%)

- Coordinate with food donors to coordinate food rescue
- Troubleshoot any issues through timely communication and creative problem solving in coordination with our food donors and charity partners
- Develop and maintain excellent relationships with our logistics partner to ensure timely, efficient and food safety and hygiene in our operations
- Support the Country Manager and co-founders in procuring operational equipment and coordinate with our suppliers and accountant to ensure quality
- Awareness of compliance with relevant HACCP food safety and local food rules and regulations

Key Responsibility Area 2 - Donor and Charity Relationships (20%)

- Develop and maintain relationships with local food donors from management to department leads
- Respond in a timely manner to Food Donor and Charity Partner questions, feedback, and requests for information. Provide personal follow-up ensuring excellent service is given to all
- Support the Country Manager in conducting outreach to expand food rescue partnerships with both food donors and charities
- Provide support in onboarding food donors and charities
- Present an image that mirrors that of the values and professionalism of VietHarvest (purposeful, professional, responsive, and passionate)
- Aid and support corporate partnership initiatives when required locally

Key Responsibility Area 3 – Data & File Management and Administration (10%)

- Ensure that accurate and timely data on food collection and delivery is collected and stored in collaboration with our logistics company
- Monitor quality/quantity of food donations and analyse trends, creating reports from and analyzing program data as needed
- Maintain current and accurate updates and data in multiple platforms, including our existing and target donor and charity database
- Ensure adherence to best practice policies, processes and procedures and good governance
- Compliance with other Government regulations

At VietHarvest we are a small family and all work together to contribute to ensure we are delivering on our purpose to Nourish our Country. In order to deliver on our purpose:

- There is an expectation that for all major events we, as a family, come together and take on additional responsibilities to deliver a successful event
