Context

Strategic Education Advisor specialised in Learning through Play in primary education and Teacher Professional Development in the Hanoi office

This function reports to Country Programmes Manager and is part of VVOB Vietnam’s extended strategic team. The Strategic Education Advisor is an expert in the field of Learning through Play in primary education and Teacher Professional Development, providing guidance to the project team in this technical domain, through a close collaboration with the education and MEAL departments. As a member of the extended strategic team, the Strategic Education Advisor contributes to shaping the strategy of VVOB Vietnam.

The Strategic Education Advisor will:

- design and develop relevant and scalable projects in close collaboration with internal and external stakeholders.
- provide both short- and long-term strategic advice, information, and guidance to the project teams and VVOB’s partners on (a) specific educational domain(s), in line with policy trends, new developments and the latest research and thinking in education and international development.
- take up a variety of roles in the capacity development process according to the needs, particular situations, and phases of the programme.
- create and manage partnerships and strong networks with relevant partners, institutions and organizations.
- contribute to internal and external knowledge development and learning, by systemizing lessons learned and sharing pro-actively lessons learned between partners, colleagues and other VVOB country teams.
