BACKGROUND

The research project, *Understanding the Non-Profit Sector in Vietnam*, recognizes that non-government; non-profit organizations are crucial to the development and advancement of civil society. It thus focuses on the emergence of the non-governmental, non-profit sector in Vietnam. It seeks to achieve the following key objectives:

- To gain understanding of the development of the non-governmental, non-profit sector;
- To understand the role of the non-governmental, non-profit organizations in addressing social issues;
- To identify the challenges facing the non-governmental, non-profit organizations;
- To identify opportunities for supporting and strengthening the non-governmental, non-profit sector; and
- To establish a partnership network with non-governmental, non-profit organizations in Vietnam as a basis for future collaboration.

The research study will involve (1) interviews with leaders of 15 non-profit organizations; (2) visits to the participating non-profit organizations and observation of their work; (3) three focus groups with leaders of at least 30 non-profit organizations; and (4) interviews with 30 community members who have benefited from activities of non-profit organizations. Research activities will take place in Ho Chi Minh City, Ha Noi and Da Nang between May 15, 2013 and July 31, 2013.

This research project has been approved and supported by the University of Calgary. Dr. Hieu Van Ngo, from the Faculty of Social Work, will lead the research. The University of Calgary is located in Calgary, Alberta, Canada.
