Ref. Emergency relief to NARI typhoon-hit areas in Central Vietnam

Dear colleagues,

The People's Aid Coordinating Committee (PACCOM) sends its compliments to you all and would like to share the following:

Within the first 2 weeks of October, the central provinces of Vietnam were severely affected by two typhoons, WUTIP and NARI. Moreover, heavy rain after NARI in the provinces of Nghe An, Ha Tinh and Quang Binh caused serious consequences, with a death toll of 22 (as of 21<sup>st</sup> October 2013), submerged over 96,000 houses and damaged a vast number of crops and public facilities.

On the basis of situation reports of the Central Committee for flood and storm control (CCFSC) and the UN Resident Coordinator in Viet Nam, PACCOM has joined the efforts of other stakeholders to call for emergency assistance from international (non-governmental) organizations, to affected communities and people in those storm-hit provinces.

In order to help typhoon victims overcome this difficult time, your assistance and support would be most encouraged in the areas of livelihoods (food, shelter, household sets, seedlings, agricultural infrastructures...), health care (clean water, medicine, restoration of service at commune health stations...) and education (repair and reconstruction of classrooms, equipment, study materials...).
