Dear colleagues,

The People's Aid Coordinating Committee (PACCOM) sends its compliments to you all and would like to share the following:

The recent flood in central provinces of Quang Nam, Quang Ngai, Da Nang, Phu Yen and Binh Dinh has caused serious consequences, with a death toll of 42 (as of 20<sup>th</sup> November 2013), submerged over 425,000 houses and damaged a vast number of crops and public facilities.

On the basis of fact findings, PACCOM has joined the efforts of other stakeholders to call for emergency assistance from international (non-governmental) organizations, to affected communities and people in those flooded provinces. In order to help flooded victims overcome this difficult time, your assistance and support would be most encouraged in the areas of livelihoods (food, shelter, household sets, seedlings, agricultural infrastructures...), health care (clean water, medicine, restoration of service at commune health stations...) and education (repair and reconstruction of classrooms, equipment, study materials...).
