- Supports the Senior Program Manager with project DPME activities such as needs assessment, base line survey, new project development, project monitoring, evaluations and reporting.
- Provides relevant trainings for local partners, communities and home partners per agreed outputs.
- Provides inputs to facilitate promotion of HFHV innovations that may benefit the community by serving a greater number of families.
- Encourages and builds mutual trust, respect, and cooperation among team, partners and families.
- Develops and encourages local leadership in taking larger roles to positively impact their communities and needy families therein as part of sustainable program development a shared HFHV vision among partners.
- Supports and facilitates the volunteer program activities.

- Clear communication & presentation skills; Computer proficiency in MS Word, Excel, presentations, virtual communications.
