Viet Nam is now facing the fourth wave of Covid-19 which has spread to 31 provinces/cities and caused highest number of new Covid-19 cases so far. As of 28 May 2021, the Ministry of Health has reported 6,396 confirmed cases, 2,853 recoveries, and 46 deaths. Though many prompt and effective measures have been taken, Viet Nam has still faced many challenges in combating the pandemic.
