- Day 2 Understand what disability mainstreaming entails. Introduction to project cycle.

 Discuss about policy setting in a DM project.
- Day 3 Understand the formulation, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of a DM project. Discuss the final evaluation of a DM project.
- Day 4 Map the policy process. Learn to deliver the message. Understand the criteria of a disability inclusive organization. Assess your own organization.
