What is dual training?

Dual training combines vocational training at a vocational school and apprenticeship in a company in one course. It makes the training practical and guarantees jobs for participants after the training.

What would I learn in the dual training in basic hairdressing and skin care?

Help customers having a healthy and beautiful hair, meet professionally the customer's needs and help them having a comfortable and enjoyable experience.

What can I do after the training?

✓ Join an advanced training course

This is a basic training to provide you with a foundation to start your career in hairdressing. You can follow advanced training or specializing courses.

✓ Work in a hair salon

This is a dual training meaning that you have school sessions and apprenticeship sessions at hair salon. After the training, if you meet the salon requirements, you may be contracted to work at the salon. You will also be able to apply to job in other hair salons.



Apprenticeship in a hair salon

The duties of the trainee change over the apprenticeship as she gains experience from the salon. In the beginning, she observes the senior stylists as they cut and style hair, asks questions about the techniques and completes very simple tasks. As the apprenticeship progresses, she may also be allowed to shampoo and prepare clients, and assist senior stylists with their work. Towards the end of the apprenticeship as she completes the training, the salon may allow her to take on her own clients.

Certificate

Participant who passed the examination after the 14-week dual training will be awarded with a certificate co-issued by Enfants&Développement (E&D) and L'Oréal Vietnam.
