AAT has always been a leader and a pioneer non-profit organization that reached incredible success that has caused great changes in Vietnam. Thanks to our successful actions, AAT created a trustful relationship with the authorities and the police, allowing us to have access to all persons recognized as victims, which is unusual in Vietnam. AAT works closely together with partner organizations. AAT is also a task force network with a representative on 15 countries around the world.

Currently, the number of victims keeps growing while funding opportunities for our actions are decreasing. AAT, in cooperation with the Vietnamese police needs to create a transit center to welcome victims. Moreover, facing the increasing number of cases, without extra help, AAT is no longer able to support more costs for repatriation, rescue in foreign countries, micro-credit, and psychological and health care.
