FHI 360 is an international non-governmental organization that, in Vietnam, promotes the health and well-being of the Vietnamese people, particularly vulnerable and marginalized populations. It works with the Vietnam Ministry of Health and other national bodies, as well as provincial and district-level health services to achieve project aims. FHI 360 is currently implementing programs to address HIV prevention, testing, and treatment; combatting trafficking in persons; COVID-19; tuberculosis case finding and treatment; anti-microbial resistance; health system strengthening; maternal and child health and nutrition; and diagnostic and laboratory services.

The Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) project is a five-year, global project focused on HIV, COVID-19, and combatting trafficking in persons using funding from the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief and the United States Agency for International Development. EpiC is seeking a qualified and highly motivated Vietnamese candidate to serve as **Technical Advisor, HIV Prevention - USAID-supported Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) project**, based in **Hanoi or Ho Chi Minh City**. **Candidates with requisite experience may also be considered for Associate Director level.**

Main responsibilities:

Technical Leadership (~60%)

- Lead team implementing HIV prevention, testing, and HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) programming.
- Oversee technical capacity building among project staff and community-based partners in area of expertise.
- Work with community-based partners to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of demand generation.
- Develop and lead innovations in HIV prevention and testing programming.
- Ensure continuous quality improvement is applied at all levels of the health system.
- Review program data and make appropriate programmatic pivots to meet targets and fill service gaps.
- Develop manuscripts, presentations, and other knowledge products promoting successes, lessons learned, and knowledge gained to advance the global HIV response.
- Lead reporting and respond to ad hoc requests related to HIV prevention.

Team Leadership (~40%)

- Supervise a team of up to four individuals.
- Define strategy for improving HIV prevention and document in work plans and subcontracts.
- Collaborate with sustainability-focused staff to ensure the financial sustainability of community-based HIV prevention interventions.
- Represent organization at national and international events.
- Facilitate collaboration and a supportive environment with implementing partners and other project staff.
- Other duties as assigned.

Experience and abilities for the position:

- Bachelor's degree in public health, social work, social sciences administration, quality improvement or related field; advanced degree, including master's in public health or a medical doctorate preferred.
- At least 10 years' experience in management or technical implementation of international development projects in Vietnam, preferably in HIV outreach, testing, counseling, or clinical care.
- Exceptional skills with Microsoft Excel, Word, and PowerPoint.
- Experience with USAID, PEPFAR, and the Vietnam Administration of HIV/AIDS Control preferred.
- Well-developed written and oral communication skills in both Vietnamese and English.
- Ability to travel as necessary.
