

CARE INTERNATIONAL IN VIETNAM AN END PROJECT SURVEY CONSULTANT OPPORTUNITY

CARE International in Vietnam is seeking **one** or a team of **national consultants** to conduct End Project Survey for Drought preparedness and mitigation to support communities to sustainably live with recurrent droughts. This is 16 day assignment, starting from 20 March, 2009

Project Description

The Community led Drought Mitigation (Drought-OFDA) is a regional two year program running from September 2007 to May 2009, implemented in three projects across EastTimor, Vietnam and Cambodia. Within Vietnam, the project is implemented in three communes of three districts in Binh Dinh province. The goal of the program is to enable poor households to sustainably live with recurrent drought.

Major responsibilities

The Consultant is required to lead a quantitative survey and participatory review process to examine following key topics related to the project achievements:

- (i) results versus verifiable indicators set in the intervention framework and
- (ii) effectiveness of intervention activities

Qualifications and working experiences

The consultant will have extensive experience, knowledge and skills in planning and implementing project survey and review. In particular the consultant will be competent in quantitative and qualitative research, evaluation tools development, data collection and analysis, and have highly developed report writing skills. Ideally, the consultant will have experience in review or evaluation in rural livelihood or household economic assessment, efficiency livestock and agricultural development.
