The Wildlife Conservation Society (WCS) is a US-based conservation organization registered as a non-profit organisation and has been dedicated to conserving the earth's biodiversity since its establishment in 1895.

The Wildlife Conservation Society's program in Vietnam addresses the critical conservation issue of illegal hunting and trade in wildlife. Vietnam is both a major consumer of wildlife, and also a transit country whereby wildlife is imported from other countries to its west and south, and re-exported. Hence, it is an extremely important link in the trade chain for illegal wildlife.
