TERMS OF REFERENCE

TOR FOR CONSULTANCY ON ADJUSTMENT ON RICE CULTIVATION TECHNIQUE IN QUANG UYEN, NA RI AND BACH THONG DISTRICT, CAO BANG AND BAC KAN PROVINCE

I. INTRODUCTION

ChildFund Vietnam is the representative office of ChildFund Australia - an independent and non-religious international development organisation that works to reduce or eliminate poverty for children in the developing world.

ChildFund Australia is a member of the ChildFund Alliance - a global network of 12 organisations which assists more than 16 million children in over 50 countries. With a focus on child-centered development programs that are undertaken in partnership with more than 1,400 local communities, the Alliance puts more than \$503 million (USD) to work each year to help deprived, excluded and vulnerable children.

ChildFund has been operating in Vietnam since 1994. ChildFund Vietnam works to achieve our mission through our integrated community development programs: Access to Quality Education, Child Rights and Child Protection, and Building Strong and Resilient Communities. Each of these three programs integrates projects from our five core sectors, health, livelihoods, water and sanitation, education and child protection to ensure that our programs address the widest range of needs at the community level and also address the causes of poverty. Our activities are coordinated and planned with our partner communities at local and district levels to ensure out programs complement existing community and government activities and are designed with meaningful input from children and their communities. ChildFund Vietnam is supporting children and their communities in Hoa Binh, Bac Kan and Cao Bang.

The current rice cultivation technique in project communes of Quang Uyen, Na Ri and Bach Thong district have been considered unsustainable resulting in unsustainable yield. It is therefore necessary to find out the adjustment on this matter while still keeping promotion of farming household incomes.

II. OBJECTIVES

To recommend the sustainable rice cultivation technique in all project communes in Quang Uyen, Na Ri and Bach Thong districts.

III. CONSULTANT'S TASKS

- Organizing the field survey to find out the problem and constrains related to rice production.
- Recommending the adjustment on rice production which is applicable for communities with different economic status and field conditions. Getting agreement on the models by district and commune staff.
- Delivering the training on seedling, transplanting and pest control on summer rice to district technical staff and farmer trainers in all project communes.



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- Coaching the trained farmer trainers on their delivering the training on the same topics to farmers to make sure the quality of the training by farmer trainer and their training skills and methodology.
- Participating in the assessment workshop at the end of the season to withdraw the the lesson learnt and recommendation for the adjustment.
