The DPP lasts for 2 full-time months and 4 part-time months at place of work and is offered to development practitioners in Central and Southeast Asia, Africa and Latin America. It is also open to Swiss and other 'Northern' countries candidates working in international cooperation, whether they are based in the field or at the headquarters of their organisation.

#### Who can apply?

To apply candidates should be working in governmental agencies, international and local NGOs, international organizations, bilateral cooperation agencies, or private organizations in positions related to development aspects. Scholarships are available for candidates coming from the Mekong Region (Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos and Myanmar) and Switzerland

The criteria for selection are: Professionals with key positions in public, private and NGO sectors, or civil society associations; University degree (minimum 3 years) and several years of professional experience (or an equivalent combination of training and experience); Employer's letter of commitment; Proficiency either in English, French or Spanish; Optimal age between 30 and 45 years
