"We Learn to Live Green" is a journey where we invite students to participate in the green action aimed at changing individual behavior which spread to the community and head towards a sustainable lifestyle, through the form of "The Green Ecoteams" in schools, as a way to attract students and community to actively participate in activities to mitigate climate change. Each ecoteam has about 8 students. From weekly lessons, students are invited to experience their lifestyle through 10 topics, for example: Waste, Water, Health, Plant, Energy, Social Relationship ... then express their concern towards nature, the environment, relationships with families, friends and the community with practical actions in family and life in order to form and spread to the community a green lifestyle, sustainable living such as sorting, recycling and reusing waste, saving energy, water. They measure the results of their actions through cubic meters, kilowatt power from other devices in their homes, then compare their results before and after learning lesson, as well as restrict the use of plastic bags, use eco bags or lane when shopping...

With their Ecoteams, students' skills are improved for example: questioning, listening, scanning and skimming skills. They also share personal experiences with their groups, making decision and finding appropriate solutions to their circumstances. In addition, students have the opportunity to demonstrate their abilities, prove their actions and persuade others to follow, as well as taking different roles such as leader, note-taker... in the team.
