

LEARNING FOR CHANGE WORKSHOP

Learning from our experience of climate change education

Introduction

Learning for Change (L4C) Workshop is collaborative effort between Action for the City (ACCD), Center for Development of Community Initiative and Environment (C&E) and Global Action Plan (GAP) International, Sweden. L4C Workshop engages the participants in intensive interactions and reflections based on their own experience, resulting in (social) learning, thus enhancing their capacity to continue their work with greater effectiveness and longer term impact.

Approach

The workshop uses the L4C method developed by GAP International to improve the sustainability of education and social change projects. The method provides participants with the space to reflect on their own experience, and to share experiences of managing climate change education projects. Through a series of exercises, participants explore different layers related to their own cases and projects, and are encouraged and coached to develop new solutions in cooperation with other practitioners, formulating concrete follow up plans. The workshop thus lays the basis for a new platform for learning and action.

Objectives

- To create conditions for participants to assess and learn from/for their climate change education projects.
- To enable participants to experience new approach, tools and models, for planning, designing, managing, implementing and evaluating climate change education projects.
- To promote exchange and cooperation among the participants, while strengthening the existing network.

Target group

Participation is opened to environmental and sustainability education practitioners in universities/colleges and ministries, school teachers and education managers, and NGOs. **They should have experience with change- and action-oriented education for sustainable development (ecological, social, and economic)**
