### “Consultation workshop combined model visit on renewable energy contributing to greenhouse gas emission reduction”

**To:** Mitigation Sub-Group Members & CCWG’s Members

In December 2011 the Government of Vietnam approved the National Climate Change Strategy (NCCS). NCCS clearly indicates that the development of renewable energy (RE) is one of the important tasks to reduce greenhouse gas emissions (GHG). As part of the Action Plan in 2013, Mitigation sub-group of the Climate Change Working Group (CCWG) is organizing a consultation workshop on renewable energy combined with model visit in Hanoi.

#### **Objectives of the workshop:**

- 1) Sharing and updating information on potential and current situation of renewable energy in Vietnam;
