"The production and use of goods and services that respond to basic needs and bring a better quality of life, while minimising the use of waste and pollutants over the life cycle, so as not to jeopardise the needs of future generations" (*Norwegian Ministry of Environment, Oslo Symposium, from Planning for change - Guidelines for National Programmes on Sustainable Consumption and Production, UNEP*).

At the United Nations climate change conference in Bali, UN Secretary General Ban-Ki moon stated that: "We have an ethical obligation to right this injustice. We have a duty to protect the most vulnerable. That is why any agreement should look to developed countries to continue taking the lead on curbing emissions. And developing nations need to be given incentives to limit the growth of their emissions. Together, we can spur a new era of green economics, an era of truly sustainable development based on clean technology and a low-emission economy"

Young people, future leaders in businesses and families, are encouraged to engage in sustainable production and consumption through many activities within the framework of the "**Green Empowering Contest**" and lots of other activities from Live and Learn and EuroCham's Green-Biz 2013. Consequently from 15. April 2013 on Young people can take their chances to improve their knowledge through series events of trainings, workshops and even field trips are organised in May and June 2013 in Hanoi, Danang and Ho Chi Minh City with the engagement of international and national experts, government officials, NGOs and business in this field.

Moreover the Contest provides opportunities for students to not only search for good practices but also experiment to find out feasible solutions for households, businesses and their communities, during the summer months of July and August, 2013. The best entries from the Contest will get high-ranking visibility, be published and displayed in course of the European Green Business Solutions for Vietnam (Green-Biz 2013) conference and exhibition on 19 and 20. September 2013 in Melia Hotel, 44B Ly Thuong Kiet, Hanoi.
