China and Myanmar are dialogue partners who attend MRC meetings and exchange information with the member countries. The MRC offers analysis, provides advice, conducts research and monitors the status of water and related resources for the countries' mutual benefit and the people's wellbeing, across the basin. It has several strategic areas of focus, which currently include agriculture, irrigation and forestry, basin development planning, environment and climate change adaptation, flood management and mitigation, drought management, fisheries, sustainable hydropower and navigation.
