1. Background

Plan Vietnam was established in 1993, is an international child centered community development organization. Plan is working in partnership with local people; organizations and government bodies to help children in Vietnam meet their basic needs as well as expand their opportunities to reach their full potential.

Plan Vietnam is implementing an OFDA funded project through project objective and main results as the following:

Goal

To reduce vulnerability and increase the coping capacities of populations living in areas most affected by recurrent natural disasters in Vietnam.

Principal Objective: To reduce vulnerability and increase the coping capacities of populations living in the areas most affected by recurrent natural disasters in Vietnam.

Specific Objective: To increase resilience in local communities and institutions through the active engagement of community members (particularly women, children and other vulnerable groups) in activities to better prepare for, mitigation and respond to natural disasters.

Result 1. Local populations (at least 50% women, children, ethnic minorities and wider community) living in disaster prone areas have increased awareness of local disaster risks and coping mechanisms

Result 2. Eight communes have increased preparedness to cope with and respond to disaster risk through participatory planning, enhanced early warning systems, and small-scale mitigation works at the local level

Result 3. Local authorities (at Provincial, District, and Commune level) in Kon Tum Province and Quang Tri province in extension phase have increased capacity to implement CBDRM in line with the national program on CBDRM

Result 4. CBDRM and Climate Change Adaptation (CCA) best practices are documented in the province and contribute to the National Program on CBDRM, in collaboration with other INGOs working on CBDRM in Vietnam

This project commenced in June 2012 in Kon Tum province and extended to Quang Tri province in second phase from July 2014. In the second phase, the Project will cover 8 communes in 2 provinces including: Ba Long, Hai Phuc, Huc Nghi, A Doi, A Xing, Pa Tang (QT) and Ngoc Tem, Dak Nen (KT). Plan Vietnam is about to conduct the pre and post-survey at household and institutional level in line with defined indicators

2. Objectives of the end-line survey

A post KAP survey will be conducted from March to April 2015 with the same methods and sample at the end of the project to make the comparison of before-after intervention, compared with pre-KAP results conducted in October 2014. The objectives of end-line survey are to measure project intervention impact in relation to the change in knowledge, attitude and practice.

3. Methodology and sample size:

- Quantitative Questionnaires, randomly selected in 04 villages in each commune, 05 communes in 03 districts of two provinces (accounting for 60% of the targeted communes)
- At grass-root level: 120 interviewees per commune: 80 adults and 40 children interviewee per commune. Total: 600 interviewees (50% of the interviewees should be women; 50% of the interviewees should be living under the poverty line according to MOLISA criteria)
- At institutional level: 40 Governmental and mass organization staffs, including: Committee for Flood and storm at province, district and commune level, Department of Education and Training at district level, Red Cross at communal level, Women's Union at communal level, Principle of school, teacher, leader of People's committee (50% of the interviewees should be women)

4. Scope of work

- To review relevant documents related to this survey, including the project document, list of indicators and sample of pre KAP survey conducted by Plan in the beginning of the project, for background information of this mission. Documents will be provided to the consultant by Plan.
- To draft and discuss with Plan the agreed design of the study methodology and sampling method
- To prepare a detailed plan for implementation of the pre KAP survey, including technical design and preparation, training of data gathered, field data collection, data entry, data cleaning and analysis, as well as reporting and presentation of the final report to Plan
- Training of data collectors from the project areas and monitor during data collection.
- Use SPSS or any other analysis software to analyze the baseline data collected from 05 communes of
 which one commune of Kon Plong district (Kon Tum province) and 04 communes of Huong Hoa and
 Dakrong district (Quang Tri province). The analysis will generate holistic statistics information on
 knowledge, attitudes and practices of target groups. Statistics will be divided by gender and
 comparisons between the intervention and control communes in each province to highlight the true
 contribution of the project.
- To write a narrative report (not more than 40 pages with appendixes) and the outline of report should refer to Annex 1.
