- Venue: Vân Hồ Exhibition Center - No. 2 Hoa Lu street, Hai Ba Trung, Hanoi

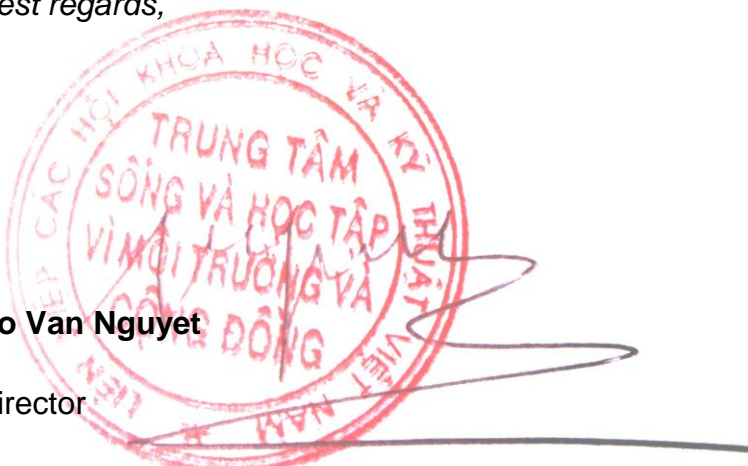
