Countries in Asia-Pacific have embarked on ambitious Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and a long-term low emission development path to achieve the climate change goals.

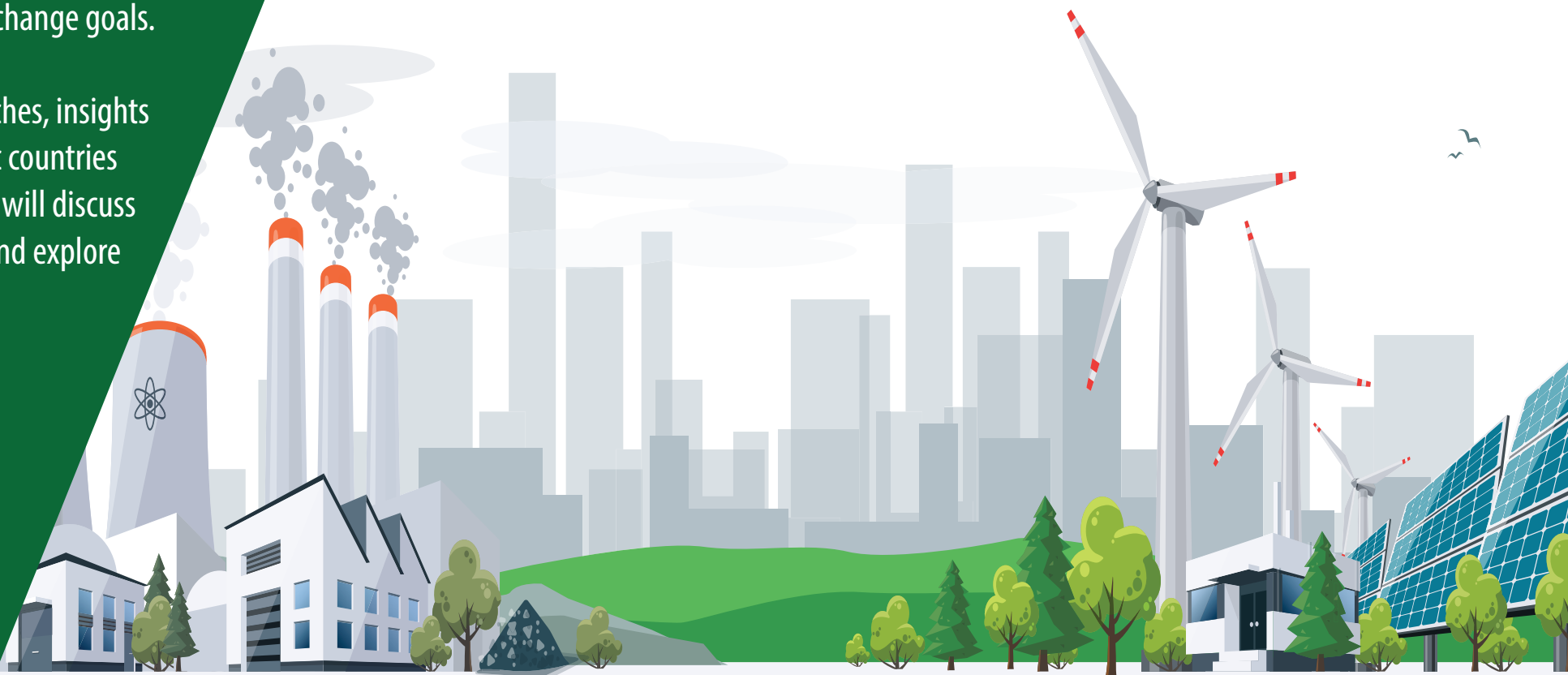
