Positioning Climate action as an social just opportunity to develop Vietnam towards a resilient and low carbon future.



The Government integrates, resources & implements community-based adaptation and/or mitigation initiatives in at least 22 provinces at risk by 2020.



Advocate for most ambitious mitigation targets based on remaining carbon budget for the targets (with international support)



Position CCWG as a reliable and supportive partner in the field of climate action for the relevant governmental institutions



Position inclusive renewable energy, gender equality and resilient community champions as a blueprint to protect & increase living conditions communities at high risk

Advocacy tactics

Raise awareness about the importance of community based adaptation/mitigation approach in planning and implementing climate change policies

by researching and disseminating information best practices and successful CBI models in Vietnam

by developing common positions and recommendations from civil society organizations

by engaging with key ministries and pm'sto influence relevant key national policies/programs and their implementation processes
