Objective and Purpose of the Assignment

Viet Nam Oil and Gas Group (PVN) is strengthening its strategic responses to increase its contribution to greenhouse gas emission (GHG) reduction, to play its part in the government of Viet Nam's targets in mitigating climate change and to achieve the commitment on net zero emission by 2050 in COP26 in November 2021. A green energy transition strategy is under preparation aiming to shift PVN's operations and value chains to increase climate adaptation in oil and gas exploration and production, petroleum technical services, as well as to expand its businesses into new energy and renewable energy sector. ADB and PVN have a mutual interest in fostering a strategic partnership to promote energy transition development in Viet Nam, with a focus on PVN's Energy Transition Programme including offshore wind power. Specifically, ADB will assist PVN and its subsidiaries to assess opportunities as developers/investors of offshore wind power projects and/or as contractors in the offshore wind supply chain. Based on this assessment, ADB will support PVN to develop an offshore wind power roadmap and prepare an offshore wind power project.

ADB is looking for an international energy specialist and a national specialist (the Consultants) to support ADB and PVN in preparing the initial background paper for offshore wind power roadmap preparation and scoping offshore wind power study for investment project preparation.

Scope of Work

Under the guidance of ADB and PVN, the International Consultant shall work on an intermittent basis for 55 person-days with the scope of work as follows:

- Leveraging the consultant's expertise and on international and regional best practices, review available documentation on Viet Nam's offshore wind sector, including the legal framework, policies and regulations, industry structure and value chain, technical requirements and prerequisite capabilities, case studies, etc. and provide high-level evaluation of Viet Nam's potential in offshore wind;
- Prepare the initial background paper, offshore wind power roadmap, and PPT presentation;
- (iii) Draft the scope of offshore wind power technical assistance (TA) scope that could lead to the prefeasibility study and investment project; and
- Support ADB in conducting consultation meetings with PVN and other stakeholders.

Detailed Tasks and/or Expected Output

The Consultant shall implement the following task but are not limited to:

- Review international and regional best practices and Viet Nam's offshore wind power sector from the legal framework, policies and regulations, industry structure and value chain, technical requirements and prerequisite capabilities, case studies, etc;
- Review PVN and Viet Nam's potential, target, and barriers to energy transition in offshore wind power;
- Based on available studies, documentation, and mesoscale wind mapping and time-series data sets derived from different appropriate reanalysis data sets (e.g. MERRA-2, ERA-5), combined with any available measurements from masts and other ground-based devices provided through PVN, the Consultants will identify a list of options for offshore wind power investment projects in Viet Nam, which can be developed by PVN as demonstration project(s). The mesoscale data will be purchased by the international energy specialist at an ADB's approval and to be reimbursed. The reanalysis source data used is itself synthesised from diverse data sources (e.g. weather balloons and ground-based measurements), as well as satellites. At least the following information should be included in the list of options: tentative location (province or area), wind data collection from Satellite and another available source, capacity (MW), generation (MWh), technologies, length of transmission line (km), voltage (kV), connection point, investment cost (million US\$), preliminary Levelized Cost of Energy (LCOE), economic and financial indicators, financial viability, benefits, risks and opportunities, ranking. The site screening and selection will include a fatal flaw analysis;
- Suggest a few options for offshore wind power supply chain projects for PVN in Viet Nam;
- Prepare the PPT to discuss the offshore wind power site selection, investment projects and supply

- Conduct consultations with relevant stakeholders including ADB, PVN, the Ministry of Industry and Trade (MOIT) and the Committee for Management of State Capital at Enterprises (CMSC), etc;
- Finalize the proposed offshore wind power investment project(s) and the offshore wind power supply chain projects for PVN in Viet Nam;
- Preparation of a roadmap for PVN engaging in the offshore wind power industry;
- Prepare a draft project proposal (concept note) for the proposed offshore wind power investment project (s). It is a desk-based study without any site survey and measurement. PVN shall use the draft project proposal to consult with relevant authorities (such as MOIT, CMSC, etc.) to allow PVN to prepare the investment project as the current regulations (such as the inclusion of the proposed project into the national power development planning, approval of investment policy document, feasibility study, technical design). It might require consultations with ADB, PVN, MOIT, CMSC, and the local authorities in the project province; and
- Draft the offshore wind power TA scope between ADB and PVN (investment project scope, list of
 activities, cost estimate, timeline) and terms of reference (TOR) that could lead to the Phase II prefeasibility study and detailed feasibility study. In this process, the Consultant shall work with ADB,
 PVN, MOIT, and CMSC.

Minimum Qualification Requirements

Minimum Qualification Requirements for the international energy specialist:

- (i) A university degree in energy or financing or other related fields;
- (ii) At least 10 years of directly relevant professional experience in offshore wind power, energy transition, and financing; experience in similar countries like Vietnam will be an advantage;
- (iii) Working experience in Viet Nam's energy sector is required;
- (iv) Experience working with the international donors (ADB, WB, KfW, etc.) will be an advantage;
- (v) Fluency in English with excellent writing and communication skills; and
- (vi) Strong interpersonal skills to develop effective working relationships with the counterpart agencies and other key stakeholders.
