1. BACKGROUND

During the period 2014 – 2016, VVOB Vietnam is implementing the Early Education Programme together with Departments of Education and training at Province level (DOET), Teacher Training Institutes (TTIs) and Provincial Women's Unions (PWU) of 4 provinces (Thai Nguyen, Nghe An, Quang Nam and Quang Ngai) as well as the Department of Teachers and Educational Administrators of the Ministry of Education and Training (DTEA/MOET) and Vietnam Women's Union (NWU) at national level. Within the programme, transition from kindergarten into primary is a main focus and will be addressed to support in-service of teachers and school leaders, pre-service teacher education and through parenting education to ensure that kindergarten and primary teachers, school leaders and parents have sufficient knowledge and skills to support children in transition in preparing for and adjusting to the new learning context in primary school.

To achieve the set objectives, a model of cooperation among schools and parents to support childen in transition from early education to primary education is being established. Within the framework of the model, improvement of capacity of kindergartens' and primary school managers in change management is an important step. As such, VVOB Vietnam has planned to revise a manual on this topic (from a manual which was developed for lower secondary school managers within the framework of Education Programme 2008-2013) and train kindergartens and primary schools' managers.

2. OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE OF THE CONSULTANCY

The consultancy aims at

- (i) producing a training manual that will be used for a 2-day training workshop on change management, focusing especially on transition issues.
- (ii) facilitating two TOT workshops, each lasting 2.5 days

The target group for the training manual consists of educational managers at provincial, district levels and school leaders from kindergartens and primary schools, who will later use the manual in their multiplication trainings to school leaders in their respective provinces. The manual is also meant to be used as a self-study package for potential school leaders.

To deliver this task, the team of consultants could consist of 2 education experts, preferably including one early childhood education expert and one primary education expert.. Consultants are invited to apply by submitting a full proposal that describes clearly:
