**Job Summary:**

With excellent community mobilization, facilitation and participatory skills in community development, the PO is the key strategic link between HFHI/Vietnam program team, implementing partners and local communities. With experience in transformational social development from a values-led perspective, the PO is the key resource in supporting all HFHV programs in the Central region; particularly its micro-finance led housing, water and sanitation community and global village projects.

**Main Accountabilities:**

- Supports and facilitates the volunteer program activities in preparation of logistics
