Duty station: Hanoi, Viet Nam

Main responsibilities:

In close cooperation with the project team and the counterparts of the Ministry of Finance (MoF), the main responsibilities of the Programme Officer will be:

- The provision of technical and process advisory to the national counterparts in the Ministry of Finance (MoF)
- The preparation, coordination and implementation of nationwide project activities related to public financial management reform, namely the organization of technical trainings, workshops, consulting missions, international fact-finding missions among others
- The maintenance of existing and fostering of future cooperation and exchange between all involved international and local stakeholders
- The monitoring, evaluation, and documentation of activities and their impact on public financial management reform
- The support of other programme activities when required

Minimum requirements:

- A Master’s (MSc, MA, MBA) degree or equivalent in Economics, Public Administration or Law
- A minimum of 5 years of relevant occupational experience in a comparable position and field, professional knowledge of fiscal policy instruments and public financial management would be an asset
- Very strong experience in working with state institutions in Viet Nam, preferably with MoF
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills with a strong interest in international cooperation and development
- Excellent language skills in Vietnamese and English, good knowledge of German would be an asset

- Excellent IT-skills are a must
- Willingness to travel on short trip, both within Viet Nam and possibly abroad
