The MEL Associate Director, as part of the project leadership team, will provide monitoring and evaluation (M&E) and research support for strategic decision-making and oversee routine M&E; data visualization and use; research; and learning. S/he will be responsible for developing and monitoring a high-quality and adaptive approach to data collection, analysis and use by all project stakeholders as well as developing methods and milestones to monitor the project's progress towards its goals, and contributing to program strategy to ensure that activities and assignments are carried out as planned and the program objectives are being achieved.

Key Responsibilities:
