The main responsibility:

The climate change project officer has the responsibility to manage several outputs of climate change resilience projects in the Mekong Delta provinces. The project officer will participate in strategic project planning, budgeting, and M&E. The Project Officer is part of our project operational team and will also interact with income generation and inclusion programs.

Requirement:

- Minimum of BA in environmental science, social science or other relevant fields
- At least three years of relevant working experience and project management. In exceptional circumstances candidates with less than three years' experience may be considered.
- Experience working with community sustainable development and participatory approaches, result based management targeting vulnerable groups, CBOs, mass organizations and local government. Experience from working with local communities in the Mekong Delta will be an advantage.
- Efficient, reliable, able to work independently and in teams.
- Fluent oral and written communication skills in Vietnamese and English
