ROLE PURPOSE

Plan International (PI) is an independent child rights and humanitarian organization dedicated to ensuring children live free from poverty, violence, and injustice. We unite children, communities, and like-minded individuals to create lasting, positive changes in children's and young people's lives. PI equips children, especially girls and women, who are often marginalized, with the skills and confidence to claim their rights for a fulfilling future. With over 80 years of experience and active in more than 75 countries, Plan International Vietnam (PIV) aims to support 2 million girls in Vietnam to learn, lead, decide and thrive.

PIV is set to implement the first cycle of the "Zurich Climate Resilience Alliance" (ZCRA) project in 10 communities in Quang Tri and Quang Binh provinces from January 2024 to December 2027. This project applies the Climate Resilience Measurement for Communities (CRMC) framework, which includes the Alliance's framework for measuring community climate resilience and a practical tool for implementation. The ZCRA's objectives in Vietnam are:

- Community resilience to climate-induced natural hazards in Quang Tri, Quang Binh, is enhanced through gender-responsive and inclusive disaster risk management (DRM) planning.
- Local government authorities in rural, peri-urban, and urban areas across Vietnam will facilitate the implementation of inclusive, community-based climate resilience actions.
- National government agencies will create an enabling environment for youth-centered climate resilience initiatives and adopt the DRM planning approach piloted at the commune and district levels.

In Quang Tri and Quang Binh, Plan International Vietnam (PIV) will collaborate with provincial Red Cross Organization, local authorities, primarily at the commune and district levels, to implement the project, while maintaining close collaboration with ISET for national activities and advocacy efforts.

DIMENSIONS OF THE ROLE

The Project Officer, under the supervision of the Provincial Partnership Manager, will be responsible to deliver the project's activities in accordance with the approved work plan and donor's compliance in assigned locations.

ACCOUNTABILITIES

Take the role of Local Project Lead that align with CRMC:

- Allocate time for research activities, including coordinating with the research team, data collection team, and members, reviewing methods (quantitative, factors/indexes), and ensuring consistency and completeness of information during the research period.
- Support the Project Coordinator and M&E Specialist in analyzing results and making informed decisions.
- Manage and organize community-specific information for assigned areas.
- Develop and select appropriate research methods and assess data sources within the communities.
- Assign tasks to field workers and oversee their activities
- Conduct T-line studies to gather immediate information following disasters.

Project delivery

- Collaborate with partners and stakeholders to develop clear, detailed project activity plans, ensuring transparency and ease of implementation at the assigned location in consultation with Project Coordinator.
- Coordinate with partners and stakeholders to ensure project implementation and monitoring align with the project design, including gender-transformative approaches and child participation, contributing to Plan International's goal of supporting 2 million girls in Vietnam to learn, lead, decide, and thrive.
- Regularly report and share working schedules and activities with the Provincial Partnership Manager (PPM) and Project Coordinator for optimal project support and partnership management at the provincial, district, and commune levels.
- Conduct monitoring trips with the involvement of local partners and project's participants as per the M&E plan to track project activities, outputs, and results, providing necessary monitoring data, including photos, for project reporting and donor requirements.
- Prepare the progress update, quarterly and annual reports for the assigned and submit them to the Project Coordinator for consolidation, or prepare ad-hoc reports as requested.
- Ensure all technical supports of Project Coordinator are integrated into the project implementation.
- Assist and coordinate donor or NO visits as needed.
- Provide logistical and technical/financial support during external consultants' visits, and participate in consultations with consultants when required.
- Ensure all documentation is retained in compliance with Plan International Vietnam (PIV) and donor requirements.

Partnership

- Establish and maintain strong relationships with partners at various levels, local authorities, and beneficiaries in the assigned communities.
- Collaborate with the Provincial Partnership Manager (PPM) and Project Coordinator to implement advocacy and influencing activities with relevant partners and local authorities at commune, district, and provincial levels. This includes efforts to mobilize resources, scale up successful project models after the pilot phase, and support advocacy efforts.
- Maintain an open and accountable communication mechanism with partners at all levels to ensure timely information exchange and prompt resolution of any issues arising during project implementation.

Internal networking

- Actively engage in technical networks within Plan and the ZCRA to learn and share lessons learned and best practices.
- Contribute to program innovation by communicating ideas and proactively proposing solutions to challenges in implementation.
- Participate in monthly Technical Management Committee (TMC) meetings with CHNO and the Project Coordinator, providing project progress updates as required.
